2 Budget Update-

- Budget is in process of being voted on by board of education, still in same predicament, Naylor's projected enrollment is 630 but last week the enrollment reached 700.
- May 28<sup>th</sup>-Bosnian Parent Leadership Conference will be held. Mr. Boro Banjac & Mr. Gendre will provide workshops that will cultivate the Bosnian heritage as well as address other cultural components. It will be a pipeline to college. Eventually it will be developed into a Statewide Leadership Conference. Future expansions include Statewide Latino & African American Conferences as well.

- Co-President resigned early in year, Vice-President resigned today, Treasurer is out due to surgery. SGC needs more parental involvement. Milly Areniegas will facilitate the nomination process. Parent meeting will be held May 8 at 5:30 in the auditorium. A nomination form will be developed and sent home. Once nomination forms are returned names will be put on the ballot, then an election day will be scheduled.
- Uniforms-Students requested a change in the uniforms colors, to eliminate the blue and use the school colors purple & gold. Middle school would use purple and gold for PK-5. Amy will create a survey to send to parents regarding uniform change. Change for school year 2013-2014 pending outcome of parent survey.
- Registration can start after lottery.

3a. School Improvement Plan & School Accountability Plan-

- What makes an effective School?-Teachers have been examining the components of what makes an effective school during PD's and staff meetings. The Leadership Team

is creating an action plan based on these outcomes. Once completed Mr. Gendre will bring it to the SGC for review and input.

- School Improvement Plan-is the road map that Naylor will use to improve our efforts and measure whether our goals are being met.
  - Current data is showing measures of improvement.
  - 50% return of Parent Survey answers were in the 90%ile.
  - Most positive results were in K-5, while middle school results were less positive.
- School Accountability Plan-will be created by SGC. Retentions and transitional grades will put in place to address the students who are not meeting grade level expectations.

3b. Parent Compact-is a school/Family statement of intent-will be discussed in depth at next meeting.
